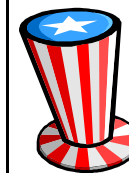

Secretary's Corner

First, I would like to welcome the 118 new members from T or C. Grand Exalted Ruler James Nichelson signed the Executive Order approving the merger of the two Lodges (T or C #2750 and Deming #2799) on June 22nd. That means once it is brought to a vote at the convention next week in Orlando, it will be official. We welcome you to what will be known as Deming Lodge #2750. Per statutes, new membership cards will be issued to paid-up former members of T or C in the near future. This will involve new membership numbers for those in T or C. I am currently in the process of investigating the best way to import these members into CLMS (Chicago Lodge Membership System). By the way, according to Grand Lodge, those who have already paid their 2010-11 Dues in T or C are good until April 1st. However, those who are delinquent will need to pay the Deming Lodge dues, which are \$66.75 for a regular members. There is a list of those delinquent in both Lodges in this newsletter. Dues should now be sent to Deming.

It is also my sad duty to report the death of two members. Both Cesar Rodriguez and Jim Sloan PER passed away during the month. That means our current membership is 326, up from 202 at the beginning of the Lodge year.

We have two applications pending investigation: Susan J. (Sue) Wolfe is being proposed by Susan Burdette, and Carole Almanza by Rosa Esparza. Wolfe was read at the meeting on June 17th. Almanza will be read on July 15th. We also have a reinstatement pending, and will vote on that at July meeting.

Merger

An Executive Order approving the merger or consolidation of T or C and Deming Lodges was signed on June 22nd by Grand Exalted Ruler James Nichelson.

That means once delegates give their approval in Orlando, it is a done deal.

With the merger, Deming takes on the assets and liabilities of T or C Lodge.

While it was initially thought that it might take months or years to sell the T or C Lodge building, we recently received some good news. There is a potential buyer, and he already has his financing in order.

The Trustees are currently working on getting an appraisal of the building. Before the building can be sold, we will need to follow the procedures for a Grand Lodge building permit per 16.050 Grand Lodge Statutes. That means it will need to be announced at a meeting, and an election set. All members, both

in Deming and T or C, must be notified. And at least 2/3 of those present the night of the ballot must vote in favor of the sale.

We had discussed with members in T or C the possibility of allowing the continued use of the Lodge building, but we feel this direct sale, without the need of a real estate agent, is too good to pass up. We will keep you updated on the process.

All members in T or C will be issued new membership cards shortly, possibly in July. We will ask for a vote on July 15th to make all T or C life members, life members in the newly merged Lodge.

For those who have already paid their 2010-11 dues, you are good through April 1st, 2011. For those who have not paid, you will now need to pay the Deming annual dues, which are \$66.75. That includes both Grand Lodge and State Assessments. Again, welcome T or C members!
